



CD ROM ADDENDUM

In order for Dreamweb to run from CD, it must create a directory on your hard disk to store temporary files. This is done automatically by the installation routine on the Dreamweb CD. To run the installation routine insert the Dreamweb CD into your CD drive and follow the instructions below;

- 1) At the DOS prompt type D: (assuming your CD-ROM drive is labelled as D:).
- 2) Now type INSTALL (followed by Return).
- 3) Follow the on-screen prompts. A directory will be created on your hard disk and you will be ready to play the game. Follow the instructions in the User Guide.

CD-ROM Addendum - (Additional)

Some CD-ROM configurations may cause problems with this version of DREAMWEB. However, such a configuration can be modified to combat these problems. If you experience corrupt graphics or sound, then follow the procedure below.

You will need a spare floppy disk which you are happy to erase/format.

1. Turn your machine on as normal.
2. Exit Windows or any other environment manager you may be in.
3. Enter your spare disk into the floppy drive and type the following:

FORMAT A: /S (Return) (assuming floppy drive is A:)

4. Wait while the disk is formatted and made "bootable"
5. Press (Return) when asked for "Enter volume name" and press N when asked to "format another disk?".
6. Type the following:

A: (Return)
COPY C:\CONFIG.SYS (Return)
COPY C:\AUTOEXEC.BAT (Return)
EDIT AUTOEXEC.BAT (Return)

7. The last line above should have taken you into the DOS text editor program and also listed the contents of your AUTOEXEC.BAT file.
8. Find the line which includes **MSCDEX.EXE** (on-screen) and, on the same line, look for **/E**. (This is crucial).
9. In order for DREAMWEB to work correctly, the **/E** must be removed from the line. Use the arrow keys or a mouse to position the underline cursor behind the **/E** and delete it with the backspace key.
10. Save the change to your AUTOEXEC.BAT file by doing the following:
 - i) Use the left mouse button or press the ALT key then 'F' to highlight the FILE menu.
 - ii) Click with the left mouse button on SAVE or simply press 'S' (Do not activate 'SAVE AS').
 - iii) Wait for the floppy drive light to turn off.
 - iv) Exit the editor program by highlighting the FILE menu and click on EXIT or simply press 'X'.
11. Now with your "boot" disk in the drive, simply reset your machine (or power off and back on).
12. Start the game in the normal way (as advised at the end of the installation procedure).
13. When you want to play DREAMWEB in future, simply boot your machine with the "boot" disk and start the game in the normal way.
